Pray God's Plan to Heal Our Land:

"If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from haven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land." -2^{nd} Chronicles 7:14

Pray in Humility and Repentance:

- Acknowledge to God your own utter dependence on Him and surrender your whole life to Him
- Ask God to show you your own sin—whether large or small—and tell Him that you repent of that sin and leave it behind to move forward in full obedience to Him.

- for God given wisdom for our leaders; we ask the Lord to reveal himself for a personal relationship with each one, and to open their ears so they will know the voice of God and be led by his direction. (Daniel 2:19-23)
- to raise up and place his favor and wisdom upon men and women who, like Joseph and Daniel, can solve problems and bring solutions (Proverbs 18:16)
- for our legislators for clear minds and the ability to be well informed so as to pass good laws for our state. (Proverbs 25:2, 14:34)
- for protection and wisdom for the Governors of each State. May they be visited by the Lord and make Godly righteous decisions.
- to protect our state and all other states from any social unrest, terrorism, warfare, and any geo-physical disaster. May our state leaders be postured and ready to face any crisis and deal with any challenge that manifests
- For God's will to be done and His government to come, that godly leaders would be elected in the upcoming election (Matthew 6:10)

For Elected Officials at Every Level, from the White House and the US Capitol to City Halls and Township Boards, We Pray and ask the Lord...

- for protection and safety for our leaders and their families

- to place wisdom, understanding and insight upon leaders to solve problems and find solutions that preserve and uphold the Constitution (Proverbs 8:12-18)
- For God's will to be done and His government to come, that godly leaders would be elected in the upcoming election (Matthew 6:10)

For our Supreme Court Justices and Other Judges, We Pray and Ask the Lord...

- for the spirit of the Lord to rest upon them with discernment, wisdom, knowledge and understand and the fear of the Lord as they make decisions for the people. (Isaiah 11:2-4)

- to cause us to be receptive and responsive to Your Word (Nehemiah 8:8-9)
- to lead us back to You as our first love (Revelation 2:4), where we love You with all their heart, soul, mind and strength (Matthew 22:37-38), and where we love each other as we love ourselves (Matthew 22:39)
